Subject: **Requesting site extensions under the NMA**

Contractors submit NMA site extension requests through the NMAPC Web site at **www.NMAPC.org**. Upon completion, the form is transmitted **directly** to the applicable international union(s) for review.

Site Extension Procedure:

1. Visit **www.NMAPC.org**;
2. Click "**Site Extension Requests**," located in the second navigation row;
3. The next screen will require you to login;
 - Enter your username and password;
 - Use the 'Login Help' link or contact 703.841.9707 if you need this information;
4. The next screen will explain what the Site Extension Request is;
 - Click "**File a Site Extension Request**," located at the middle of the page;
5. The next screen will be the Site Extension Request Form;
 - To complete the Form you will need: Facility Owner Name, Plant Name, Project Name, Approximate Start & End Dates, Local Union Number(s), Approximate Number of Craftsmen, and a Brief Description of the Work;
 - Complete the form;
 - Fields marked with an asterisk (*) are required;
 - Click "**Continue**," located at the bottom of the page.
6. You will receive an Email when the Union(s) have taken action, You can also Refer back to **www.NMAPC.org** to follow the progress of your request;
 - **If you have questions regarding the status of a request, or need to expedite your request, please contact the international union directly;**
